This has been a long winter, and now that spring is here we are like the old groundhog that has appeared to see his shadow. We were in MI in April and back to IN for a few days, OH, and KY. We are at the present time in a mission's conference in Springfield, OH.

The winter months were busy in our Jerusalem. There are a number of churches in our home area that we stay busy with in all day services, fill in work and youth work. These opportunities are appreciated and we do not take them lightly.

We have noticed an interest from churches about our expenses to travel. This is a very real issue and it cost us about 53 cents a mile if gas stays at 3.50 a gallon. All we ask is that you meet our expense and take up a love offering each evening. There is no set fee or anything like that. We are trying to book our meetings together in the areas we go, to keep us from making unnecessary trips. If we go 300 miles in our R/V it's also 300 miles back and that's about 318\$ just in fuel. The up side of all this is that there is no motel bill for the church. Now that I've shared all that news you may wonder why? It's because everyone ask how it works! Now don't misunderstand me this is not a complaint and I haven't seen the world stop traveling or folks not going to the events of the world, so we just keep on traveling but doing it as smart as we can.

In every meeting we have seen many folks to the altar and an interest to serve our Saviour. I suppose it is the young people that we love to see make decisions to serve God. We also try to challenge churches to reach the Latino people in there areas. We will make Spanish Bibles available, John and Romans, and Spanish tracts. As always we supply them at no cost to you. Remembering the whole while that paper cost money and if you would like to help out, a roll of paper is about 600\$.

Bonnie is doing well and will not have surgery at this time. We do appreciate your prayer in this matter and we are leaving it in the Lord's hands. The electric wheel chair that she has is such a blessing in our home and as we travel.

To sum it up the last few months have been busy, trying, yet blessed, with many decisions and 5 young people expressing their need for salvation.
